

4063: Elimination of Tariff on Imported Goods under Japan-Peru Economic Partnership Agreement

Japan is to either eliminate or reduce tariffs (concessions) in line with the schedule described in Annex I of the EPA. Categories of concession such as tariff elimination, tariff reduction and tariff rate quota, etc. are prescribed in the “Notes for Schedule of Japan” of Section 1 of Part 2 of Annex 1 (Reference)

Column 4	Description	Examples of products
A	Tariff elimination as from the date of entry into force of EPA	Asparagus(fresh), Wood products, etc.
B n	Tariff elimination by gradual and uniform tariff reduction on a yearly basis in “n+1” phase from the base rate n = 3,5,7,10,15,16 (First reduction: Date of entry into force) (Subsequent reduction: April 1 of each year)	Asparagus(processed), Oranges, Jumbo flying squid(Dosidicus gigas), etc.
P	Tariff reduction under conditions specified in the Notes in the 5 th column	Trout (frozen) , Yellowfin tunas (frozen) , etc.
Q	Tariff rate quota	Pork, Chicken, Maize (Confectionery or Non-alcoholic beverages) , etc.
R	Negotiate on tariff commitment in the 5 th year	Pineapples, Orange juice (frozen) , Tomato purée, etc.
X	Excluded from any commitment	Rice, Wheat, Processed products of rice or wheat, Sugar, etc.
