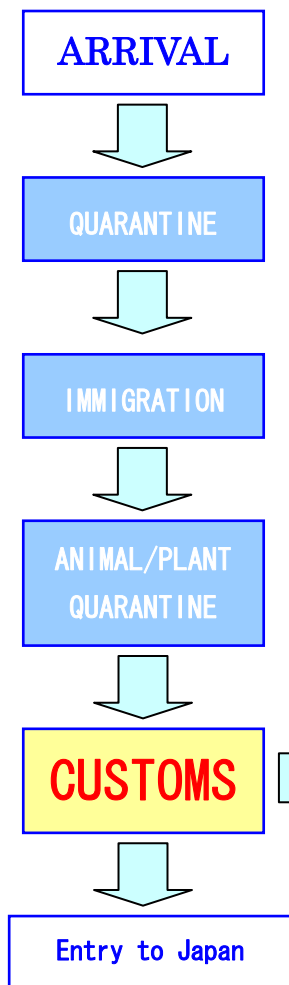


Information on Customs procedures in Japan

Duty-Free Allowance for Non-residents (per an Adult)

[attention] Commercial goods and commercial samples are dutiable and are not subject to duty exemption indicated above.

Items prohibited from importation (examples)

- Narcotic drugs, stimulants, marijuana, MDMA, etc.
- Firearms such as pistols, revolvers, etc.
- Counterfeit, altered or imitated bank notes, coins or securities, and forged credit cards.
- Obscene or immoral materials, and child pornography
- Articles which infringe upon intellectual property rights
- Explosives (dynamite etc), materials for chemical weapons.

Items Restricted for importation (examples)

- Hunting guns, swords, etc
- Internationally protected endangered animals, plants, or their products. (crocodile, cobras, turtles, ivory, musk, cactus etc)
- Live animals and plants, meat products, vegetables, fruits, rice, etc.
- Pharmaceutical products, cosmetics (subject to quantity restrictions)
