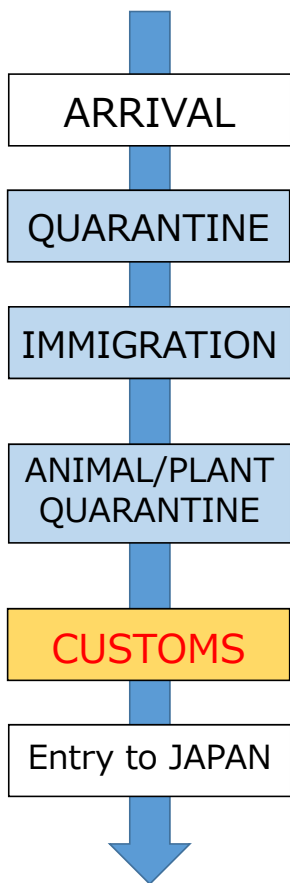

### Duty-Free Allowance for Non-residents (per an Adult)

Kinds	Amount or Value
Alcoholic Beverages	3 bottles (760ml per bottle)
Tobacco (non-resident)	400 cigarettes, or 100 cigars, or 20 individual packages, etc of heat-not-burn-tobacco 500 grams of other kind of tobacco  * Duty-free allowance of heat-not-burn cigarettes are equivalent to 400 cigarettes. * Duty allowance of Tobacco will be amended in October 2021. For your information, please visit our website.
Perfume	2 ounces
Others	¥200,000 (total overseas market value)

[Attention] Commercial goods and commercial samples are dutiable and are not subject to duty exemption indicated above.

## Items prohibited from importation(examples)

- Narcotic drugs, stimulants, marijuana, MDMA, etc.
- Firearms such as pistols, revolvers, etc.
- Explosives (dynamite etc.), materials for chemical weapons.
- Counterfeit, altered or imitated bank notes, coins or securities, and forged credit cards.
- Obscene or immoral materials, and child pornography.
- Articles which infringe upon intellectual property rights.

## Items restricted from importation(examples)

- Hunting guns, swords, etc.
- Internationally protected endangered animals, plants or their products. (crocodile, cobras, turtles, ivory, musk, cactus, etc.)
- Live animal and plants, meat products, vegetables, fruits, rice, etc.
- Pharmaceutical products, cosmetic (subject to quantity restrictions)
