
Information on Customs procedures in Japan

(NOTICE) As regulated by laws and regulations concerned, you are required to declare all the articles that you have purchased abroad or in departures/arrivals duty-free shops in Japan and are bringing into Japan. Any false declaration or failure to declare may be subject to penalty in laws and regulations I declare that the above particulars are true and correct.

Duty-Free Allowance for Non-residents (per person over the age of 20)

Description	Amount or Value
Alcoholic Beverages	3 bottles (7 6 0 ml per bottle)
Tobacco	200 cigarettes, or 50 cigars, or 10 individual packages, etc. of heat-not-burn-tobacco 250 grams of other kind of tobacco * Duty-free allowance of heat-not-burn cigarettes are equivalent to 200 cigarettes.
Perfume	2 ounces
Others	¥ 2 0 0 , 0 0 0 (total of overseas market value)

(Attention) Commercial goods and commercial samples are dutiable and are not subject to duty exemption indicated above.

Items prohibited from importation (examples)

- Narcotic drugs, stimulants, marihuana, MDMA, etc.
- Firearms such as pistols, revolvers, etc.
- Explosives (dynamite etc.), materials for chemical weapons.
- Counterfeit, altered or imitated bank notes, coins or securities, and forged credit cards.
- Obscene or immoral materials, and child pornography
- Articles which infringe upon intellectual property rights

Items Restricted for importation (examples)

Hunting guns, swords, etc

CUSTOMS

Entry to Japan

- Internationally protected endangered animals, plants, or their products. (crocodile, cobras, turtles, ivory, musk, cactus etc.)
- Live animals and plants, meat products, vegetables, fruits, rice etc
- Pharmaceutical products, cosmetics (subject to quantity restrictions)
