## 1106: Items to be Described in the Import Declaration Form

Any person wishing to import goods must declare them to the customs office. Customs declaration is made by submitting a Customs (Tax) Declaration Form to the customs office, and items which must be filled in the Customs Declaration Form are called Declaration Items.

Declaration Items include the following:

- 1. Code, number, name, quantity and price of goods
- 2. Country of origin and shipping location of goods and name and address of sender
- 3. Name and registration number of carrier (aircraft or ship)
- 4. Location of storage of goods
- 5. Other items as a reference
