

4035: Elimination of Tariff on Imported Goods under Japan-India Economic Partnership Agreement

Japan is to either eliminate or reduce tariffs (concessions) in line with the schedule described in Annex 1 of the EPA. Categories of concession such as immediate tariff elimination, gradual tariff elimination or reduction, etc. are prescribed in the “General Notes” of Part 1 of Annex 1 (Reference)

A	Tariff elimination as from the date of entry into force of EPA	Durians, Asparagus(fresh or chilled), Lobsters, Shrimps and Prawns, Wood products
Bn	Tariff elimination by gradual and uniform tariff reduction on a yearly basis in “n+1” phase from the base rate n = 5,7,10,15 (First reduction: Date of entry into force) (Subsequent reduction: April 1 of each year)	Curry, Capsicums(fresh or chilled), Dogfish and other Sharks, Sea bass
X	Excluded from any commitment	Rice, Wheat, Beef, Pork, Chicken, Tunas, Wine
