5008: Items to be Declared in the Export Declaration Form

Any person wishing to export goods must declare them to Customs. Export declaration is carried out by submitting Export (Re-shipment) Declaration Form to Customs, and the items to be declared in the Export (Re-shipment) Declaration Form are called declaration items.

- 1. Code, number, name, quantity and price of goods;
- 2. Destination of cargo and name or appellation and address or place of residence of consignor;
- 3. Name and registration number of the carrier (vessel or aircraft) of the cargo;
- 4. Location of the storage of goods
- 5. Other items as a reference
