Dried banana cut in round slices.

Manufacturing process: Fresh banana → Peeling → Trimming → Immersion

(bleaching with sulfur dioxide water solution) → Primary

drying  $\rightarrow$  Cutting  $\rightarrow$  Secondary drying  $\rightarrow$  Selection  $\rightarrow$ 

Metal detection → Packaging

Feature: Chips (approx.. 20 mm square)

White areas due to precipitation of sugar appear on the surface.

Component: Banana, sulfur dioxide (bleacher)

Application: Ingredients of confectionery or bread

Package: 5 kg / 4 bags / case

## Classification

0803.90-200

## Reason for classification

Natural precipitation of the sugars on the surface of banana is not considered as preparation otherwise than as described in Chapter 8. Therefore, the dried banana described above is classified as stated above.

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## Note:

The nature of the goods to be the basis for customs duty assessment depends on the conditions at the time of the import declaration of the goods with some specific exceptions (Article 4 of the Customs Law).

This classification example describes general replies based on the certain condition and do not necessarily represent all cases. Therefore, the classification decision on your actual importation may be different from that described here according to its condition.
