Ginger provisionally preserved

Brief description of goods

Provisionally preserved ginger mainly for transportation or storage, unsuitable for immediate consumption in that state. It is intended for further processing including desalting and served as pickled ginger or red pickled ginger.

Classification

0910.11-100

Reason for classification

Heading 09.10 covers gingers provisionally preserved by sulphur dioxide gas, in brine, in sulphur water or in other preservative solutions. Gingers prepared or preserved by vinegar or acetic acid are excluded from this heading (heading 20.01).

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Note:

The nature of the goods to be the basis for customs duty assessment depends on the conditions at the time of the import declaration of the goods with some specific exceptions (Article 4 of the Customs Law).

This classification example describes general replies based on the certain condition and do not necessarily represent all cases. Therefore, the classification decision on your actual importation may be different from that described here according to its condition.
