Coconut sugar

Brief description of goods

Sugar, manufactured by collecting the sap of cut axis of flower truss of sugar palm, boiling down to make the liquid concentrated, dried in vacuum and powdered using a powder machine.

Component: Coconut sugar 100% (Sugar content: 92%) Content of sugars: Sucrose: 86.4%, glucose: 2.8%, fructose 2.8% Weight per bag: 500 g (in Polypropylene bag)

Classification

1702.90-190

Reason for classification

Coconut sugar is obtained from a Palmaceae plant rather than that obtained from sugarcane and sugar beet. It is classified in subheading 1702.90 as powdered sugar without any preparation.

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Note:

The nature of the goods to be the basis for customs duty assessment depends on the conditions at the time of the import declaration of the goods with some specific exceptions (Article 4 of the Customs Law).

This classification example describes general replies based on the certain condition and do not necessarily represent all cases. Therefore, the classification decision on your actual importation may be different from that described here according to its condition.
