

## 7202: Procedures for Carrying out Foreign-made Goods

When carrying out foreign-made goods presently in use, such as a watch, necklace, ring, etc., fill out the names, quantity, and features of items which you carry out on the form for “Registration for Carrying out Foreign-made Goods,” submit it to Customs with the listed goods, and obtain Customs confirmation. The form is available at Customs.

If you put the foreign-made goods in check-in baggage, make sure you obtain the Customs confirmation before checking in your baggage with the airline (shipping) company.

Without the prior confirmation, these goods cannot be distinguished from articles purchased abroad when you return to Japan and they may be dutiable in some cases.

Be sure to keep this form with you because you are required to submit it to Customs upon return to Japan.

*To a passenger who is to carry out Foreign-made Goods:*

With your presentation of the Foreign-made Goods and the Customs' confirmation thereof upon your departure, these goods are recognized as being carried out from Japan and are not subject to Customs duty and/or taxes upon return to Japan.
