

✚ **Brief description of goods**

Preparation consisting of boiled mushrooms, burdock root and carrot. After the ingredients are mixed, they are packed in a pouch (airtight package) with a seasoning liquid and sterilized by heat. It is intended to be used for the preparation of Takikomi gohan (Japanese rice dish) by adding to rice when cooking.

(Component ratio)

Grifola frondosa: 18%

Carrot: 8%

Shimeji mushroom: 17%

Shiitake mushroom: 7%

Burdock root: 13%

Seasoning liquid: 37%

(Weight per pouch)

300 g

✚ **Classification**

2003.90-210

✚ **Reason for classification**

It is considered that the filling consisting of mushrooms and vegetables gives the essential character to the preparation described above. Therefore, it is classified as stated above as a preparation of mushrooms that account for the maximum weight of the filling.



Note:

The nature of the goods to be the basis for customs duty assessment depends on the conditions at the time of the import declaration of the goods with some specific exceptions (Article 4 of the Customs Law).
