

✚ **Brief description of goods**

Preparation consisting of onion, Chinese cabbage, carrot, pork, etc.. After the ingredients are heated with a seasoning liquid, they are packed in a retort package (airtight package). The preparation is intended to be poured on rice after having been warmed before serving.

(Component ratio)

Onion: 7%

Chinese cabbage 6%

Carrot: 5%

Quail egg: 3%

Pork: 3%

Cloud ear mushroom: 3%

Bamboo shoot: 3%

Shiitake mushroom: 3%

Shrimp: 1%

Seasoning liquid: 66%

✚ **Classification**

✚ **Reason for classification**

The fillings of the preparation accounts for 34 % of the total weight and that characterize the preparation. Therefore, it is classified as stated above as a preparation of vegetables that account for the maximum weight of the filling.



Note:

The nature of the goods to be the basis for customs duty assessment depends on the conditions at the time of the import declaration of the goods with some specific exceptions (Article 4 of the Customs Law).
