

✚ Brief description of goods

Medicated soap

Manufacturing process: Bactericides and fragrances are mixed into the fatty acid sodium salt obtained from palm oil and then they are molded.

Component: Fatty acid sodium, bactericides (triclocarban and triclosan) and fragrances

Feature: Solid soap (cake-like)

Size: Approx. 8 x 5 x 3 cm

Application: Washing of hands and the like

✚ Classification

3401.11-000

✚ Reason for classification

The soap is classified as stated above since it is a molded medicated soap containing bactericides.

✚ Point of classification

The “soap (only in the form of bars, cakes, molded pieces or shapes)” that is used for washing of human body (skin) such as bath soap is classified as soap for toilet use in subheading 3401.11.

**Note:**

The nature of the goods to be the basis for customs duty assessment depends on the conditions at the time of the import declaration of the goods with some specific exceptions (Article 4 of the Customs Law).

This classification example describes general replies based on the certain condition and do not necessarily represent all cases. Therefore, the classification decision on your actual importation may be different from that described here according to its condition.
