

Decision of the Joint Committee established under Article 13 of  
the Agreement concerning the Implementation of Tariff Rate Quota

1. For the purposes of Schedule of Japan in Annex 1 of the Agreement between the Government of Japan and the Government of Malaysia for an Economic Partnership (hereinafter referred to as “the Agreement”):

- (1) Certificates of the exporting Country referred to in Note 2(a)(iii) of Section 1 of Part 2 of Annex 1 of the Agreement will be issued for each export by the Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority (FAMA) of Malaysia. On the basis of the certificates issued by FAMA, certificates of tariff rate quota referred to in Note 2 (a)(iii) of Section 1 of Part 2 of Annex 1 of the Agreement will be issued by the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries of Japan (MAFF).
- (2) Certificates issued by FAMA will be written in the English language and include the following minimum data:

Certificate Number;  
Exporter’s Name and Address;  
Importer’s Name and Address;  
Description of Good(s);  
Tariff Item Number (6 digit);  
Quantity of Good(s) (with measurement unit);  
Validity of Certificate; and  
Validation stamps by the issuing authority.

(3) The forms of certificates issued by FAMA and specimen impression of stamps validating them are attached to this document. Any modification thereof will be notified by any method to the Embassy of Japan in Malaysia and be effective upon confirmation of receipt of such notification by the Embassy.

(4) Eligible importers will apply for a certificate of tariff rate quota to the International Affairs Department of the MAFF, submitting the relevant certificate issued by FAMA.

2. For the purposes of Schedule of Malaysia in Annex 1 of the Agreement, import licenses for tariff rate quota referred to in Note 1(c) of Section 1 of Part 3 of Annex 1 of the Agreement will be issued by the FAMA.

3. (1) The MAFF and FAMA will take necessary measures to prevent counterfeiting of certificates and licenses referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2.

(2) The MAFF and FAMA will exchange information on the aggregate amount of allocated quotas within a month after the allocation of quota. The MAFF and FAMA may also exchange views and information on any matter relating to the implementation of tariff rate quota and refer any problem arising therefrom to the Sub-Committee on Trade in Goods established under Article 14 of the Agreement.
