

Guidance on Electronic Declarations at Terminal 1 of Kansai Airport

Japan Customs requires all passengers entering Japan to submit a Declaration of Accompanied Articles and Unaccompanied Articles in order to prevent terrorism and smuggling, and to ensure prompt and proper customs clearance. Japan Customs recommends submitting declarations electronically via the “Visit Japan Web” for smooth customs procedures. (For more information, please check the following pages.)

Make a declaration at an Electronic Declaration Terminal (Scan the 2D code, etc.)





【Process】

Please login to the “Visit Japan Web” from the 2D code below and follow the instructions to complete the entry of your declaration information. After that, a 2D code including your declaration information will be created. If you keep a screenshot of your 2D code, you can use it offline.

All passengers, including family or any group members, must create a 2D code and complete the procedures at the terminal, one by one.



【Process 1】

Please hold your IC passport and the 2D code created in STEP1 over the scanner of an electronic declaration terminal stood at each wing shuttle station except for South Midway Station ( above show the location of terminals) and follow its guidance to complete your declaration.

【Process 2】






Terminal 1 of Kansai Airport

【Process】

Foreign residents who have not completed STEP2 procedure are asked to scan the 2D code created on VJW at the Terminals at Immigration Area. ( Above show the location of the Terminals) and follow its guidance to complete their declaration.


✂The Terminals are installed only in the area for foreigners. Japanese passengers who have not completed the procedure at the Terminals can do it at the Declaration Terminals in Customs inspection area in STEP5.



【Process】

For passengers who have checked in baggage, please check your airline and flight number on the information board (as shown by ★ below), and claim your baggage from the corresponding baggage carousel (1 to 8).







Terminal 1 of Kansai Airport



【Process】

Passengers who have already completed the procedure at the Electronic Declaration Terminals in STEP 2 or 3 follow the route guidance (a, b, c, d) displayed in the Electronic Declaration Area (indicated by the red circle below). Passengers who have not yet completed the procedure use the Electronic Declaration Terminals (shown by  below) and proceed along the route guidance (a, b, c, d) displayed.



Passengers' baggage may be inspected by Customs officers. All passenger, including family or any group members, must create a 2D code and complete the procedures at the terminal, one by one.

Important Notes on Electronic Declaration Terminals



- All passengers, including family or any group members, must create a 2D code and complete the procedures at the terminal, one by one.
- Due to the system, persons under 135 cm in height are not eligible.
- Face photos are taken for the purposes of identification at the terminal and facial recognition at the gate, and therefore passengers are asked to take off masks, sunglasses, or any item covering face.
- Even when passengers declare electrically, passengers may be asked to go to the customs inspection desk for additional purposes, e.g., in cases of personal effects beyond the duty-free allowance or unaccompanied articles.

Important Notes on the Electronic Customs Declaration Gates (e-Gates)



- All passengers, including family or any group members, must create a 2D code and complete the procedures at the terminal, one by one.
- Please proceed to the recognition area at the electronic customs declaration gates one by one.
Passengers are able to pass through the gate with carts.
- If the gate doesn't open, please follow the customs instruction and go to customs inspection desk.
