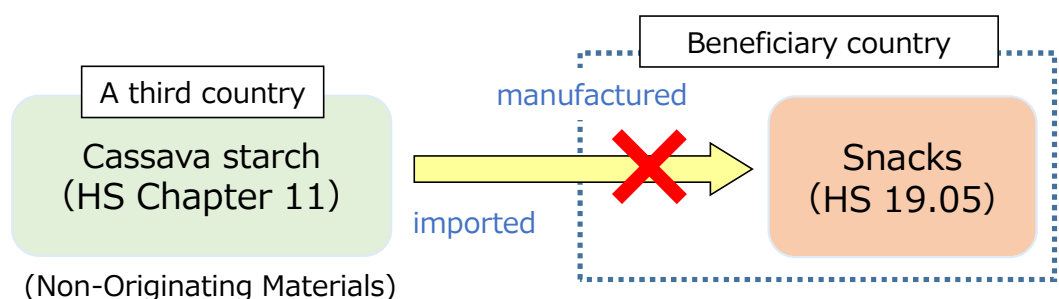

Rules to be considered as an originating good	Manufactured from products other than those of Chapter 11(excluding those of Chapter 11 manufactured from products of Chapter 7, 8 or 10, in the originating country or territory of the products* of 19.05(2) on this list) or 19. *The products in this case mean snacks.		
Outline	After checking all the materials, it was found that the non-originating cassava starch (HS Chapter 11) was used; thus the products manufactured from non-originating cassava starch do not satisfy the rules determined in the Ordinance for Enforcement of Temporary Tariff Measures Law. Furthermore, "De Minimis" cannot be applied to the product of Chapter 19. Therefore, the products are not considered originating goods of the partner country under the GSP.		



Requirements to satisfy the rules to be considered as an originating good

The cassava starch of Chapter 11 is required to be an originating material.

However, it is possible to use the cassava starch of Chapter 11, which has been manufactured from non-originating cassava of Chapter 7 in the beneficiary country, even if the cassava starch of Chapter 11 is non-originating material.

Requirements to apply De Minimis

This rule applies to the products classified from Chapter 50 to Chapter 63; thus it does not apply to Chapter 19.
