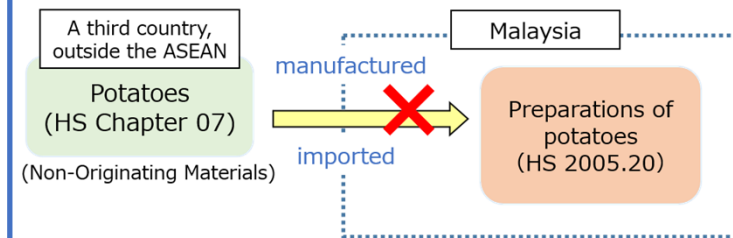


Explanatory note

Product	Preparations of potatoes	HS code	HS 2005.20 (HS2002)
EPA/GSP	Japan-Malaysia EPA	Origin Criteria (as indicated on Proof of Origin)	A (The goods are wholly obtained or produced entirely in the territory of the Country, as defined in paragraph 2 of Article 28.)

Product Specific Rules	A change to subheading 2005.10 through 2005.20 from any other chapter, provided that, where non-originating materials of Chapter 7 are used, each of the non-originating materials is harvested, picked, gathered or produced entirely in a third State that is a member country of the ASEAN.

Outline	After checking all the materials, it was found that non-originating materials classified in HS Chapter 7 were used. The non-originating materials were not harvested in a third country in ASEAN; thus, they do not satisfy the product specific rules of HS 2005.20. Therefore, the products are not considered originating goods of Malaysia under the Japan-Malaysia EPA.

Requirements to satisfy PSR

The non-originating materials, potatoes, are required to be **harvested** or gone through other processes stipulated in the product specific rules of HS 2005.20 **in a third country that is a member state of ASEAN.**

Product and EPA/GSP

This column shows a general description of the product and type of tariff preferences applied.

HS code

The HS code of the product is indicated in the Heading (4-digits) or Sub-Heading (6-digits) level. A bracket () indicates the HS version that is stipulated in each EPA.
